
AIMS/OUTCOMES: By the end of this session you will...

From M40 direction, head down Marlow Hill into High Wycombe Town centre. Follow A404 through High Wycombe. Travel past Police Station on left, Royal Mail on right. At traffic lights follow one-way system round to the right onto Easton St. Immediately look for Union Baptist Church on left. After church, look for Multi Storey Car park on left. Park here. The Hub is directly behind (within) Union Baptist Church. Access to the Hub is from car park on level 1.

From Hazlemere / Amersham side of High Wycombe proceed down Amersham Hill. Past train station on left. Follow one-way system round to the left onto Easton Street, then Immediately look for Union Baptist Church on left. After church, look for Multi Storey Car park on left. Park here. The Hub is directly behind (within) Union Baptist Church. Access to the Hub is from car park on level 1. (Hub contact number in case of difficulty 01494 473889)
